### Leadership & Management

**Strengthen the quality of leadership and management at all levels, including governance, to drive school improvement with measurable impact on pupil outcomes.**

- To re-structure leadership across the school to reflect the growth of the Early Years department.
- To develop the role of the phase-team leader to increase capacity in monitoring and evaluation capacity.

### Teaching & Learning

**Learning in English and Maths is highly personalised and address the specific individual needs of all at all points in the lesson.**

- Planned learning is progressive within English lessons, it links one learned skill to the next stage and is highly focussed on targets set for individuals.
- Structures for learning are consistent across classes, offering all learners the same opportunities to make exceptional progress.

### Personal Development, Behaviour and Safety

**Families are further engaged with the work of the school, and this has a positive impact on engagement and outcomes for disadvantaged learners.**

- A clear understanding of the needs of disadvantaged learners across the school is developed.
- Identified areas of need are rapidly addressed through astute spending of the Pupil Premium Grant.
